Independence Day celebrations are in abundance in San Diego county this year. Fireworks will be seen from every angle, from north to south counties, the beaches to the inland valleys. Here are a few of the organized events: See the **San Diego Padres** take on the San Francisco Giants July 1 with a fireworks display following the second game of the double-header starting at 7:05 pm. **Paradise Point Resort & Spa** in Mission Bay will host its annual "All-American BBQ and Fireworks Extravaganza" on Monday, July 3. On July 4, The **Maritime Museum's** Star of India Auxiliary hosts the annual Fourth of July barbecue on the Berkeley. Enjoy a free concert by the sea from 7 to 9 pm at Scripps Park near **La Jolla Cove** followed by fireworks at 9 pm. Head to **Escondido's** Grape Day Park for fireworks and general clowning around for the Fourth starting at 3 pm with fireworks commencing at 9 pm. **Rancho Bernardo** kicks off Independence Day with pomp and patriotic circumstance at 9 am at Webb Park. There are also celebrations happening in **University City, San Marcos, Julian, Chula Vista, at SeaWorld, Legoland and aboard the USS Midway!** See your Concierge for citywide activities.

Wild Animal Park's Park At Dark

The San Diego Wild Animal Park extends its hours to 8 pm (grounds close at 9 pm), during its annual Park at Dark summer season, which began June 17 and continues through September 4. Though some popular animals, such as the park's gorillas, are off exhibit, twilight trains and musical entertainment substitute to make a unique evening outing. Guests can see rhinos and constrictors do their nightly thing, while other species call out through the darkness, roaming nearby territory. Visitors can also hear live music at various locations in the park. Check the park's daily schedule for additional family activities (separate costs). The Wild Animal Park's Park at Dark program is a seasonal bonus, particularly for locals who hold annual memberships.

Del Mar Thoroughbred Club 2006 Racing Season

The season opens July 19 and continues through September 6 (dark Tuesdays). Del Mar is an exhilarating place to spend an afternoon (and spend your money).
