St. Patrick's Day Parade & Festival

Celebrating 27 years of St. Patrick's Day events, the Irish Congress of Southern California once again brings us its spirited parade and festival. This year's theme is "Celebrating San Diego's Families." The day starts at 10 am, but the fun stuff really gets moving at 11 am when the parade steps off from Sixth Avenue and Juniper Street. Participants

walk a block before making a grand turn north on Fifth Avenue, then marching about 10 blocks before turning south on Sixth Avenue. The parade ends at Laurel Street, just past the festival area and grandstand. Marchers, bands, clowns, equestrian and military units, and more than 160 floats are scheduled to roll, snap,

clomp, honk and strut this year. And don't miss the free, all-ages festival that takes place on the grassy area of the park between Sixth Avenue and Balboa Drive, between Olive and Laurel streets. Irish singing and dancing also are on tap, along with a classic car show, beer gardens and plenty of opportunities to shop for souvenirs and crafts.

ShamRock 2007 in The Gaslamp

Those Irish and Irish-for-a-day eyes will be smiling a wee bit more this St. Patty's Day when ShamRock 2007 returns to the Gaslamp Saturday, March 17 from 11 am to midnight. The 11th annual ShamRock is literally rolling out the green carpet (Astro Turf, actually) for the annual event. This year's musical block party at F and Fifth streets is set to feature Irish rock band The Fenians, DJ Dan, local Celtic bands, DJs and traditional Irish dancers. Also on tap on the turf will be plenty of authentic Irish fare, all the green beer you can stomach and dancing till midnight. Face painters, stiltwalkers, hat makers, green martinis and more will also be part of the celebration. About 20,000 people take to the streets each year to party. Tickets to ShamRock are available in advance or at the gate and include admission and food/drink specials at participating Gaslamp restaurants and bars. This event is 21-and-up only. Carlsbad 5000

Runners will take to the streets of Carlsbad on Sunday, April 1 for the 22nd annual Carlsbad 5000, the "world's fastest 5K run." The event encompasses nine separate races grouped by age and gender, with team and group competitions as well. The course is flat, fast and sanctioned by USA Track and Field. It starts in the Village at Jefferson and Grand, goes to an ocean-view loop on Carlsbad Boulevard and finishes at Carlsbad Village Drive and State. There's a \$70,000 prize, and awards and swag will go to first-, second- and third-place runners in each race. Medals will go to the top 250 finishers in each individual run. There's also a seaside after-party, with a beer garden and refreshments, and a health and fitness expo that features exhibits, free samples and deals on health, fitness and running accessories.
